Road Cleat


Please read all instructions before installing and using your cleats.

Be sure to install your cleats in a position that is most comfortable to your riding position and style.

Warning <u>A</u>

Failure to install shoe cleats properly may result in serious injury/death and or damage to your bicycle.



Installation/Use

- 1. Most cycling shoes come with a cleat cover that will need to be removed before installing your cleats.
- 2. Point the cleat forward and align the holes in the cleat with the shoe as shown in the image.
- 3. Bolt the cleat to the shoe using the supplied washers and screws.
- 4. Align the cleat to your preference before fully tightening the screws.

The vertical and fore/aft position of your cleats will depend on your preference and comfort. A good starting point though, is having the cleat positioned exactly centered underneath the balls of your foot.
