Be sure to install your fenders in a position that will allow equal amounts of clearance fore and aft.



Hardware is not included

Due to frame design differences and specifications, some applications may require modification and/or hardware other than that listed below. Parts listed below are not needed when utilizing an existing brake caliper bolt.

What you'll need: • M6 Bolt x 1 • Washer x 1 • M6 locknut x 1



Installation

- 1. Insert an appropriately sized M6 bolt, or brake caliper bolt, through eyelet on fender tab and mount to brake hole (Fig 1.) or bridge (Fig. 2), hand tighten do not torque tight.
- 2. Adjust fender so that it has equal clearance front and back. Placing a small object between the fender and tire can help keep it in place.
- 3. Tighten bolt to manufacturer's specification, use of a locknut is recommended.
- 4. Spin wheel checking for tire rub and proper clearances.
