SIMPLY DISTINGUISH SNAPIT 2.0 FROM SNAPIT


You can recognise which system is present by three characteristics:

SNAPIT

- THE NAME: Products of the classic SNAPIT system do not have a 2.0 in their name (example: BASKIT).
- THE ADAPTER: The SNAPIT adapter has 4 pins on the underside.
- THE SYSTEM BRIDGES: The system bridges of the SNAPIT carriers have four holes.

SNAPIT 2.0

- THE NAME: All products of the SNAP/T 2.0 system have 2.0 in their name (example: BASK/T 2.0).
- THE ADAPTER: The SNAPIT 2.0 adapter has two U-shaped devices on the underside.
- THE SYSTEM BRIDGES: The system bridges of the SNAP/T 2.0 carriers each have a cylinder on the underside.
