

SIMPLY DISTINGUISH SNAPIT 2.0 FROM SNAPIT

You can recognise which system is present by three characteristics:

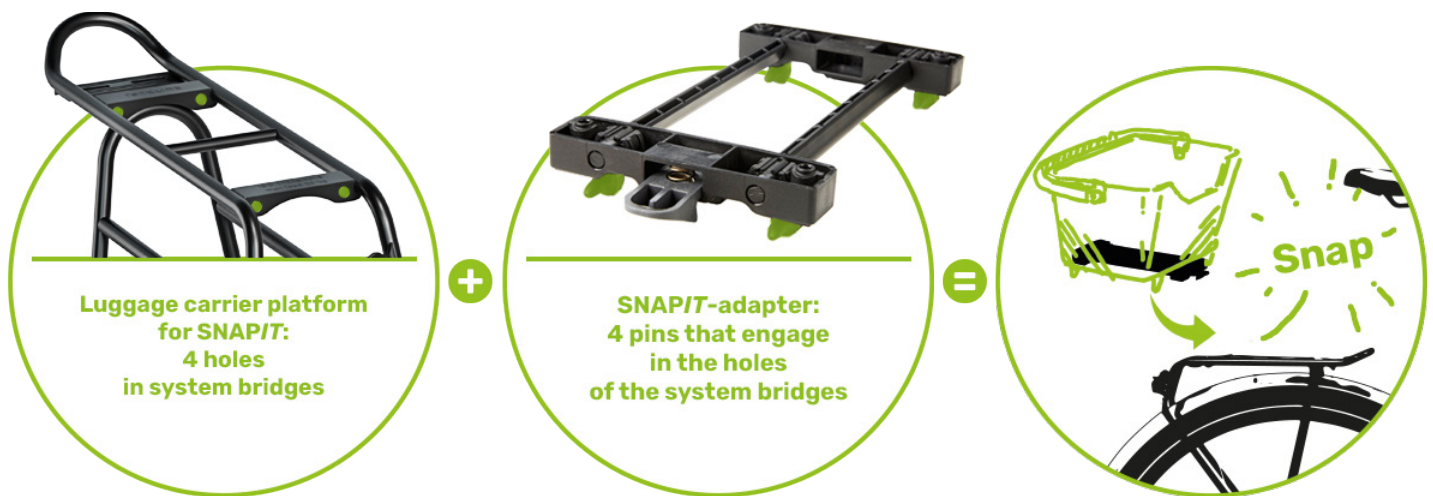
SNAPIT

- **THE NAME:** Products of the classic SNAPIT system **do not** have a 2.0 in their name (example: **BASKIT**).
- **THE ADAPTER:** The SNAPIT adapter has **4 pins** on the underside.
- **THE SYSTEM BRIDGES:** The system bridges of the SNAPIT carriers have **four holes**.

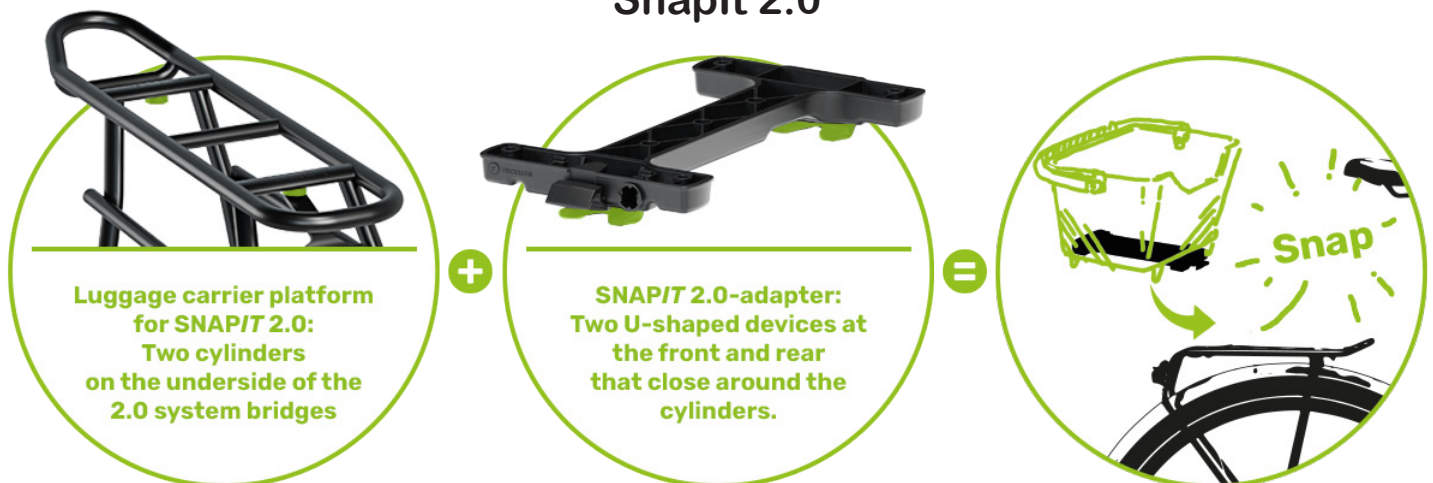
SNAPIT 2.0

- **THE NAME:** All products of the SNAPIT 2.0 system have 2.0 in their name (example: **BASKIT 2.0**).
- **THE ADAPTER:** The SNAPIT 2.0 adapter has **two U-shaped devices** on the underside.
- **THE SYSTEM BRIDGES:** The system bridges of the SNAPIT 2.0 carriers each have a **cylinder** on the underside.
